To be considered for tickets, an applicant must meet the following requirements. Approval is at the sole discretion of Broadway Grand Rapids management and does not guarantee tickets. The quantity and frequency of tickets is based on available funding.

Eligible organizations must:

1. Be a public or private not-for-profit 501(c)(3) organization or Title I schools
2. Primarily offer programs focused on youth, especially those who are economically-disadvantaged.
3. Complete the following application and meet the minimum requirements as described below.
