



TAKE IT FROM THE TOP FAQ

How do I register?

Register online by clicking the “Register” button on www.whartoncenter.com/takeitfromthetop or calling the box office at 1-800-WHARTON. Full payment is due with registration. The registration deadline is July 26, 2012, but limited space is available!

Complete and sign the appropriate permission or release form (also available online at www.whartoncenter.com/takeitfromthetop) and return via mail, fax, or email (see contact information on the form) no later than July 30, 2012.

Is this program refundable?

No, the tuition for the workshops is not refundable. Also, admission will be denied if the permission/release form is not signed and returned by July 30, 2012.

When should I arrive?

Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled start time to sign in at the registration table. Note that there may be heavy traffic in conjunction with other performances going on at Wharton Center on the days of the workshops.

What should I bring?

Bring your sheet music everyday for your song you prepared. Feel free to bring pen and paper to take notes, bottled water and a snack if you would like one. Do not bring iPads or computers and make sure your cell phones are silenced.

What should I wear?

Please plan to wear clothes and shoes that you can move and dance in! If you have dance shoes please bring them. Otherwise you should wear tennis shoes. **NO SANDALS OR FLIP FLOPS!**

Can parents or friends come and watch?

The workshops are closed – students generally feel more comfortable when family or friends are not watching. Therefore, no one other than the student will be permitted in workshop spaces, except on the first day for the welcome and overview.

Where can I park or be dropped off?

Are students are encouraged to be dropped off in front of the building in the circular drive.

Parking is available in the attached ramp, for a fee of \$1.80 per hour. Free parking is available in the parking ramp attached to the College of Law and CATA bus station on Shaw Lane, just west of Wharton Center and Bogue Street.

Participants are highly encouraged to be dropped off in front of the building. There is also a sidewalk for pedestrians to enter the building through the parking structure along the east side of the structure from Wilson Road. The sidewalk enters level 1 of the structure; access to Wharton Center is up the stairs or elevator on level 2.

Parking is free in our adjacent parking structure for the performance on Friday, August 3, 2012 (Pre-teen & Teen) or Saturday, August 4, 2012 (Advanced).
