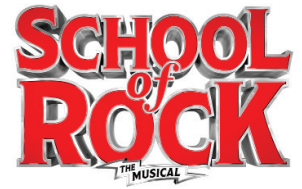

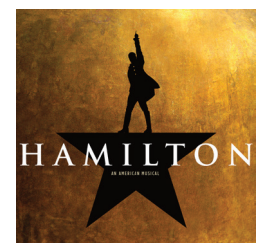
MISS SAIGON – Tuesday, March 12, 2019 at 7:30 pm
